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- 302 Adami, Prosecco, Italy (Half Bottle) 375ml** 32  
Very delicate and refined, slightly dry with elegant bubbles and a vibrant palate.
- 303 Chateau Chantal "Celebrate", Semi-Dry Sparkling Rosé, Michigan** 50  
Have a little sparkling wine from Michigan and let us show you how a great evening begins!
- 304 Domaine Laurier "Methode Champenoise", Sparkling, California** 55  
"Methode Champenoise" is a technique that results in a more full-bodied and satisfying wine.
- 305 Pierre Gerbais "Cuvee de Reserve", Extra Brut Grower Champagne, Champagne, France** 85  
A great affordable grower champagne! Green apples, ripe pears and buttered bread. Fantastic acidity and length plus generous minerality. 50% Pinot Noir, 25% Chardonnay and 25% Pinot Blanc.
- 306 Veuve Clicquot, Champagne, France** 95  
The first sip delivers freshness and the forcefulness of a well-structured and well-balanced wine that has fruit and spices.
- 307 Chartogne-Taillet, Champagne Cuvee St. Anne, Merfy, France** 125  
A graceful yet sinewy bubbly, exuding whole grain bread, mineral, honey and citrus flavors. Well balanced and on the dry side with a firm structure and a long, mineral and vanilla tinged finish.
- 507 Dom Perignon, Champagne, France (2012)** 325  
Fresh, crystalline and sharp. An aquatic vegetal world with secret touches of white pepper and gardenia with notes of liquorice and dried ginger unfurling to a smooth mellow finish.
- 508 Dom Perignon, Champagne, France (1992)** 695  
Hints of biscuit with citrus zest and black cherry. Impressions of smoked and toasted aromas with a pure and lively finish.
- 509 Dom Perignon, Champagne, France (1990)** 795  
Copper pink color, complex bouquet with exotic combinations of papaya, crystallized orange, curry leaves and sweet spices. Rounded off by marine and roasted notes.

## Cellar Selections – Limited Quantity

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- 118 Domaine Christian Moreau Père et Fils, Chablis (2018)** 115  
Hand harvested, taut structure, crisp green apple, refreshing minerality and a touch of saline that define a traditional Chablis.
- 510 Château de la Créé, Montagny Premier Cru, Burgundy, France (2018)** 144  
Fresh and youthful with expressive notes of melon, white flowers, and linen. The palate electric with layers of stone fruit and white peach. The mouth watering mineral driven finish is long and persistent.
- 204 Domaine de Bellene, Beaune Cuvée de Cinquantenaire, Premier Cru, Burgundy, France (2017)** 149  
This is pure pinot noir pleasure with aromas and flavors of black plums, red berries and a hint of garrigue. Medium to full-bodied, supple and succulent, tangy acids and powdery tannins supported by 50% new oak.
- 502 Fixin, Clos Napoléon, Premier Cru, Burgundy, France (2017)** 175  
From vines now over 60 years old and a 4.5 acre monopole of Domaine Pierre Gelin, this Premier Cru yields a pure well balanced wine, notes of cherry, earth and wood spice combined with depth and length on the palate.
- 222 Stag's Leap Cellars "Artemis", Napa, California (2018)** 115  
The infamous Stag's Leap Cellars! Known to put Napa (or American wines in general!) on the map for Cabernet; in a time period where the wine world was dominated by the French. This wine is full-bodied and has a rich finish.
- 505 Cliff Lede, Stag's Leap District, California (2018)** 158  
An opulent wine. Aromas of crushed blackberries and cassis accented by dark chocolate, black licorice, cocoa powder and espresso.
- 223 Clos du Val, Estate Merlot, Napa, California (2016)** 110  
Bold aromas of juicy ripe cherry and black berry with luxurious blue berry flavors along with smooth robust tannins.
- 501 Isole E Olena "Ceparello" Super Tuscan, Tuscany, Italy (2017)** 185  
Intense, bright ruby color with a complex bouquet ranging from floral to wild berries and spice. The palate reveals red cherries and soft tannins with a complex and savory acidity.
- 506 Marchesi Biscardo, Valpolicella Ripasso Classico, Superiore, Verona, Italy (2018)** 110  
Velvety smooth tannins with ripe berries, baking spice and cooked raisin on the palate. Crushed grapes from making amarone are used to intensify flavors in this traditional Valpolicella.
- 503 Musella, Amorone della Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy (2015)** 137  
Cozy, comforting and seductive. A biodynamic wine, from grapes dried naturally before pressing, remains in French oak for 12 months. Aromas of leather and chocolate. Flavors of black cherry bark and cooked spiced plums.
- 504 Saint Cosme, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France (2018)** 155  
From old vines. Shows great combination between richness and finesse. Elegant and powerful, distinctive velvety palate, red fruits and spell-binding notes of garrigue.
- 213 D'arenberg "The Dead Arm", Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia (2017)** 138  
Dead Arm is a vine disease that ultimately causes loss of one half, or an 'arm' of the vine, but the grapes that are growing on the other side, while low yielding, display amazing intensity.

# White Wine

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## California Chardonnay

- 114 **Landmark Vineyards, "Overlook", Sonoma** 14/54  
Buttery, oaked, notes of marzipan, honeysuckle, toast and vanilla.
- 107 **Sonoma-Cutrer "Russian River Ranches", Sonoma Valley** 62  
This wine will expand in the glass, offering up grapefruit, lemon, pear and kumquat with subtle vanilla bean and herbal mushroom.
- 123 **Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley** 95  
On the palate this wine is rich and concentrated with ripe apple and pear flavors. Citrus and mineral tones emerge in the long, crisp finish.
- 124 **Morgan Winery "Metallico", Monterey** 54  
Chardonnay in it's purest form. unoaked, aromatics of Asian pear, raw honey and baked pineapple. Crisp palate of ripe fruit and lemon curd.

## French Chardonnay

- 119 **Cave De Lugny, "Les Charms", Mâconnaise, Burgundy** 13/50  
Single vineyard, fresh notes of nuts, honey and citrus fruits and delicate fruit flavors.
- 105 **Novellum, Languedoc** 59  
One of Eric Solomon's selections, this unique unoaked chardonnay is aged on the lees of viognier. It is full and ripe, hinting of tropical fruit and gives elusive fragrance.
- 118 **Domaine Christian Moreau Père et Fils, Chablis** 115  
Hand harvested, taut structure, crisp green apple, refreshing minerality and a touch of saline that define a traditional Chablis.
- 510 **Château de la Créé, Montagny Premier Cru, Burgundy** 144  
Fresh and youthful with expressive notes of melon, white flowers, and linen. The palate electric with layers of stone fruit and white peach. The mouth watering mineral driven finish is long and persistent.

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## Sauvignon Blanc

- 106 **Frenzy, Marlborough, New Zealand** 12/46  
Vibrant, crisp, hints of peach, grapefruit, lime, melon and fresh cut grass.
- 116 **Ferrari Carano, Fumé Blanc, Sonoma, California** 54  
Barrel aged sur lie, offering pineapple, pink grapefruit, lemongrass, lychee, peach, pear, orange blossom and a touch of minerality.
- 120 **Château de Costis, Bordeaux Blanc, Bordeaux, France** 49  
Small production 100% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright nose with citrus aromas and well-balanced on the palate.
- 117 **Chateau Haut-Marbuzet, Liliane Duboscq, Bordeaux, France** 55  
This white Bordeaux is dry, fruity and subtle. Well balanced, soft and fleshy.
- 125 **Joseph Mellot, "La Chatellenie", Sancerre, France** 75  
Delicate, supple and harmonious attack. Flint Stone notes with tropical and citrus fruits. Long and aromatic finish.

## Additional Whites/Rosé

- 102 **Stella, Pinot Grigio, Umbria, Italy** 10/38  
Light and refreshing. A Pinot Grigio that is fruit-forward with apples, honeydew and citrus fruit.
- 104 **BY.OTT, Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France** 49  
Luminous, crystalline peach-pink hue, yellow fruits, pomegranate and tangerine.
- 113 **Loimer "Lois" Grüner Veltliner, Austria** 49  
Certified organic. The signature grape of Austria, dry savory notes of green apple, lemon, radish and arugula.
- 115 **Fenn Valley, Dry Riesling, Michigan** 42  
Crisp dry, fermented in stainless steel, floral nose with distinct peach and apricot flavors.
- 103 **big LITTLE Winery, "Crayfish", Pinot Gris, Leelanau Peninsula, Michigan** 45  
Hand-picked grapes fermented in French oak barrels. Crisp, bright, fresh-cut green fruit flavors with a rich, dry, refreshing finish.

# Red Wine

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## Pinot Noir

- 220 Domaines Schlumberger, “Les Princes Abbes”, Alsace, France** 68  
The range of flavors is articulated around spices and liquorice with smoky notes.
- 206 Gitton Père et fils “Taureau Rouge, Coteaux de Giennois, Loire Valley, France** 59  
Cranberry and vibrant acidity highlight this mineral driven, small production Pinot Noir.
- 217 Sass Winery, Estate Grown, Willamette Valley, Oregon** 72  
Big but elegant, dark fruit with red cherry brightness, white pepper and truffle earth. Fine tannin, silky.
- 221 Château de Chamilly, Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Côtes de Chalonnaises, Burgundy, France** 65  
A brilliant ruby red color with hints of blue violet. Pleasant aromas of wild strawberries and cherries with a friendly and refreshing palate.
- 204 Domaine de Bellene, Beaune Cuvée de Cinquantenaire, Premier Cru, Burgundy, France** 149  
This is pure pinot noir pleasure with aromas and flavors of black plums, red berries and a hint of garrigue. Medium to full-bodied, supple and succulent, tangy acids and powdery tannins supported by 50% new oak.
- 502 Fixin, Clos Napoléon, Premier Cru, Burgundy, France** 175  
From vines now over 60 years old and a 4.5 acre monopole of Domaine Pierre Gelin, this Premier Cru yields a pure well balanced wine, notes of cherry, earth and wood spice combined with depth and length on the palate.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

- 209 Justin, Paso Robles, California** 18/68  
Full bodied with black cherry and black current jam. Baking spice, dried leaf and sweet tobacco. Aged 14 months in new American oak.
- 210 Gouguenheim, Valle Escondido, Mendoza, Argentina** 49  
Classic with black fruits, spices and vanilla scented oak. Aged for 4 months in French oak, long finish.
- 205 Ferrari-Carano, Alexander Valley, California** 85  
With aromas of blackberry syrup, boysenberry, spicy black currant, espresso and caramel, this wine delights with rich, delicious flavors of Bing cherry, chocolate, toffee and anise.
- 222 Stag’s Leap Cellars “Artemis”, Napa, California** 115  
The infamous Stag’s Leap Cellars! Known to put Napa (or American wines in general!) on the map for Cabernet; in a time period where the wine world was dominated by the French. This wine is full-bodied and has a rich finish.
- 214 Penley Estates, Coonawarra, Australia** 64  
A more elegant Cabernet, this wine shows dominance of spicy cabernet fruit, a dense ripeness with hints of smoky oak and grape tannin.
- 505 Cliff Lede, Stag’s Leap District, California** 158  
An opulent wine. Aromas of crushed blackberries and cassis accented by dark chocolate, black licorice, cocoa powder and espresso.

## Red Wine (continued)

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### Additional Reds

- 216 Guigal, Côtes du Rhône, Rhone Valley, France** 13/50  
The nose is intense with fresh fruits with red berries and spices, with a palate that is round and racy.
- 223 Clos du Val, Estate Merlot, Napa, California** 110  
Bold aromas of juicy ripe cherry and blackberry with luxurious blueberry flavors along with smooth robust tannins.
- 225 Altos "Las Hormigas", Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** 46  
Essence of wild cherry, red berries, anise and tropical spices. Try it in place of a Cabernet!
- 218 Château Recogne, Bordeaux-Superieur, France** 59  
Liberally toasty with notes of espresso and spice, as well as redcurrant, black cherry and plum.
- 215 Château des Karantes, "Bergerie Rouge", Languedoc-Roussillon, France** 43  
Well balanced blend of syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre. Fruity with aromas of strawberry and cherry.
- 202 Fenn Valley, Capriccio, Michigan** 42  
Chambourcin, merlot and cabernet franc blend. Big soft red with jammy berry fruit flavor balanced with dryness.
- 207 Torbreck "Woodcutter's Shiraz", Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia** 65  
Wine made with inspiration from the Rhone Valley of France. Constantly praised for being succulent and rich, the best feature of this wine is its complexity and texture.
- 213 D'arenberg "The Dead Arm", Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia** 138  
Dead Arm is a vine disease that ultimately causes loss of one half, or an 'arm' of the vine, but the grapes that are growing on the other side, while low yielding, display amazing intensity.
- 208 Klinker Brick, Old Vine Zinfandel, Lodi, California** 54  
Berries and spice on the nose, dark, sweet fruit fills the palate with a hint of black pepper.
- 219 Rocca Di Montegrossi, Chianti, Classico DOCG, Italy** 52  
Aged in oak from Allier, Ruby with bright violet reflections, rich fruity aromas of forest berries. Harmonious and well structured tannins.
- 504 Saint Cosme, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France** 155  
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
